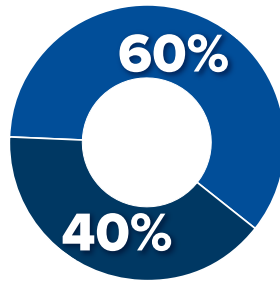

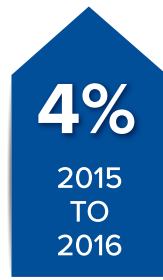

40% of job postings in the Atlanta Region are middle-skill jobs.

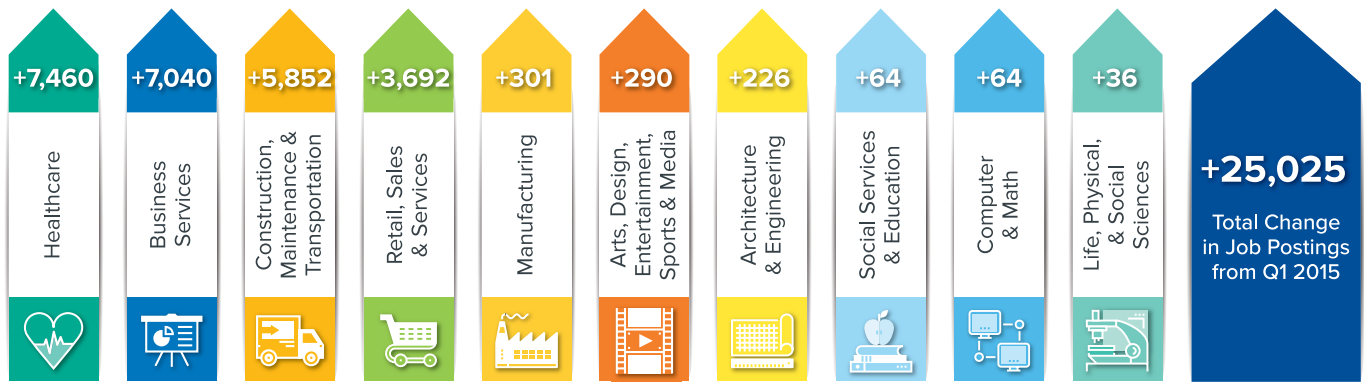


The percentage of middle-skill jobs increased by 4% from the same quarter last year.

JOB-FAMILY POSTING TRENDS, Q1 2015 – Q1 2016

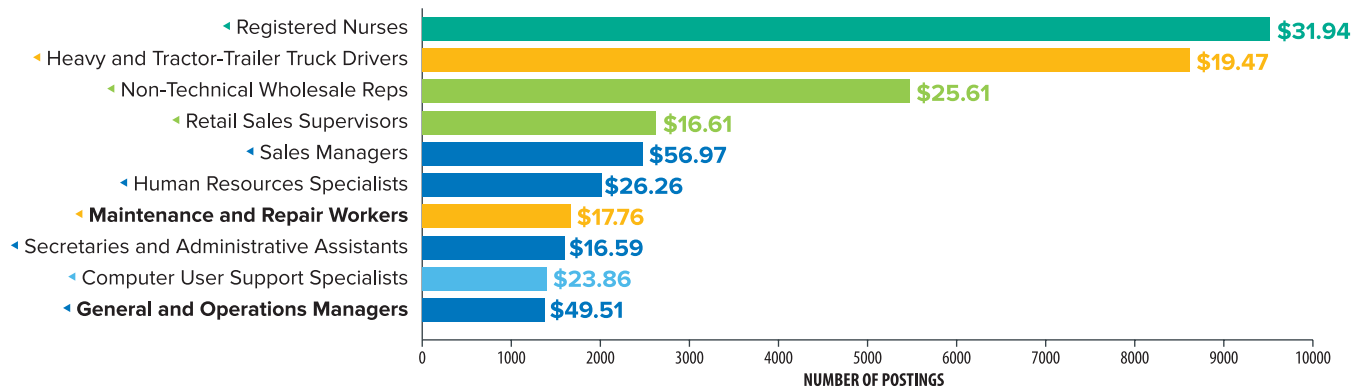

Job families are groups of jobs that require similar skills, experience or industry knowledge so that we can analyze broader categories of jobs. When comparing job families, it is important to look at the same quarter from previous years to account for seasonal hiring trends.

The chart above shows the top 10 middle-skill jobs in the Atlanta region for this quarter. The color of the bar corresponds to which job family the job falls into. At the end of the bar is the median annual wage, which means that half of the individuals in this field make more and half make less regardless of education or experience. Job titles new to the top ten jobs since the Q4 2015 report are in bold.
