The Introduction to Welding will be 40 hours of training divided into three sections:

- Introduction to the Building Trades
 - Overview of each trade occupation
 - What does it mean to be an Apprentice?
 - Hands-on tool review
 - Basic construction math prep skills
- Introduction to Welding
 - Learn basic welding processes, symbols, and tools
 - Certified instructor led activities
 - Welding booth use
 - OSHA 10 Safety Certification
- Apprenticeship tours, interaction with union leadership, and career placement activities

Upon successful completion of the program, participants must meet the following criteria to gain employment within the Building Trades:

- *At least 18 years or older*
- *Have reliable transportation*
- *Be Drug Free*
- *Legally eligible to work in US*
- *High School Graduate or GED*
